Saab has received the order for GRIPEN E from the Swedish state in February 2013 and since then been working to assemble and trial the 39-7 test aircraft. Test flights are already under way with this modified GRIPEN. In 2015, it will be joined by 39-8 followed by the two remaining test aircraft, 39-9 and 39-10.
