The first of two 72m High Speed Support Vessels (HSSVs) Australian shipbuilder AUSTAL built for the Royal Navy of Oman was launched after 13 months of construction and fitting out in October 2015. The shipbuilder was awarded a contract worth US\$124.9M for the design, construction, and integrated logistics support of the two HSSVs in March 2014 and construction commenced in August 2014.
